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THE BOLAVEN PLATEAU

About: THE BOLAVEN PLATEAU is an elevated region in Southern Laos. Most of the plateau is situated within **Champasak Province**, with the Eastern border protruding into **Sekong** and **Attapeu** Provinces. The plateau's peak elevation ranges from 1,000 to 1,350 meters (3,280 to 4,430 ft) above sea level. It is crossed by several rivers and has many scenic **waterfalls**. The name Bolaven makes reference to the Laven ethnic group which has historically dominated the region. **Click the link below for additional information:**
